Justin: Trust Lands Money

- Using TLMoney to pay for extra classes with temp teachers. 15 Full Periods, pay up for a needed full time counselor.
- Adding 1 more period to our ESL teacher. A full period costs about \$10,000 each.
- Replacing 2 or 3 rooms of chromebooks. We will continue to have a 1:1 access, so each student has access to a chromebook.

#### Questions:

Kennley: How has the new boundary changes affected our staffing?

Justin: We did lose the Leeds area and Desert Color, but DHHS is still an open boundary school, which means we will accept out of boundary students that have approved waivers. Student from 7th grade on will still have a choice which school to attend next year, but starting in 6th grade they will need a waiver for high school and not get a choice to other schools in the conesite that are not open boundary.

CTE high affects us more than our new boundaries. We are losing 70-80 students a year to the CTE because it is in our neighborhood.

CTE has been very hard to staff this upcoming year. The biggest changes we are seeing are in the computers and business classes that have dropped student numbers.
